We recommend an initial telephone reservation which will be held for seven days pending receipt of your booking form and payment of the 20% deposit. All bookings to be confirmed to us in writing.

Once the booking has been confirmed the client is liable for the full rental in the event of cancellation. Please arrange insurance.
